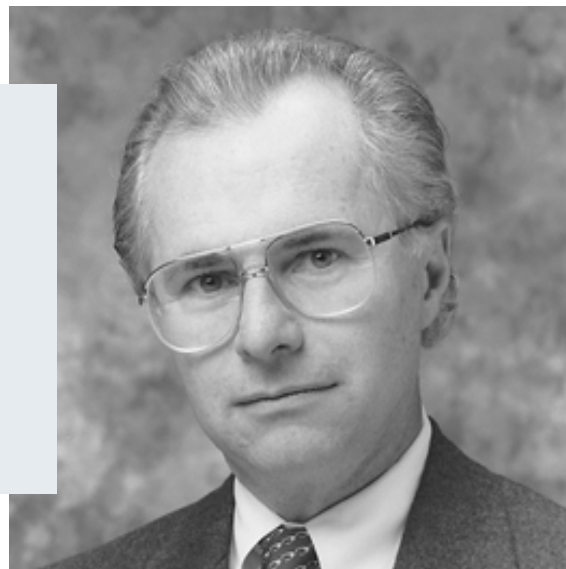


Leonard S. Sosnowski
